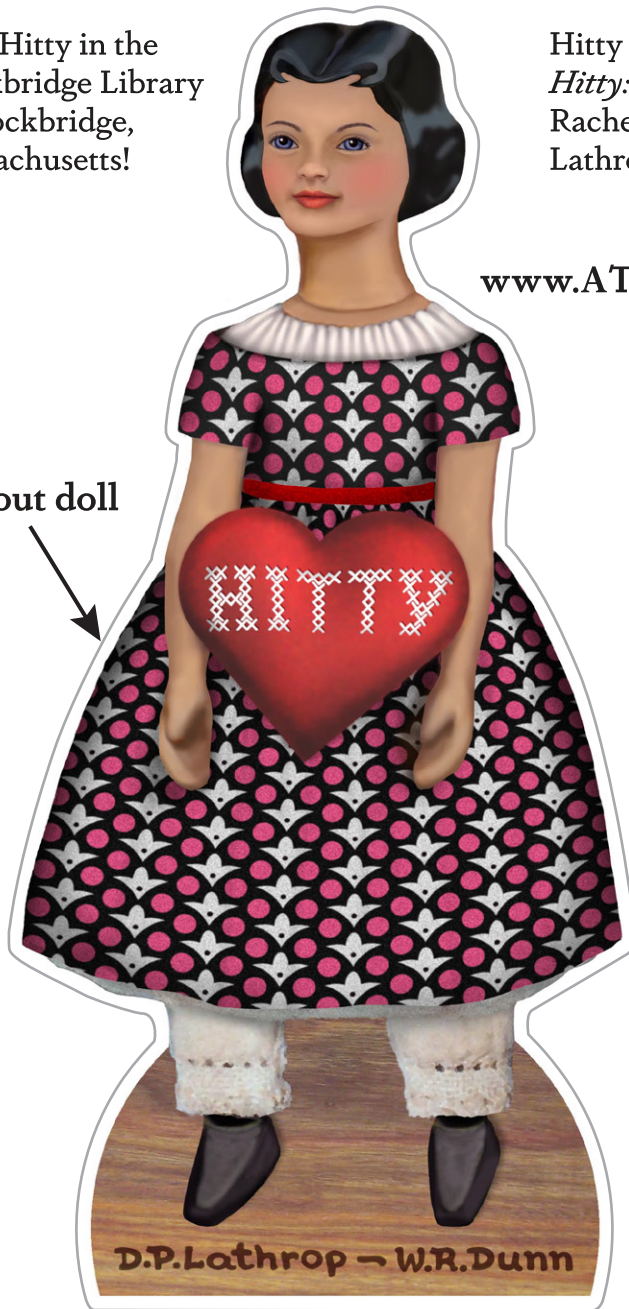

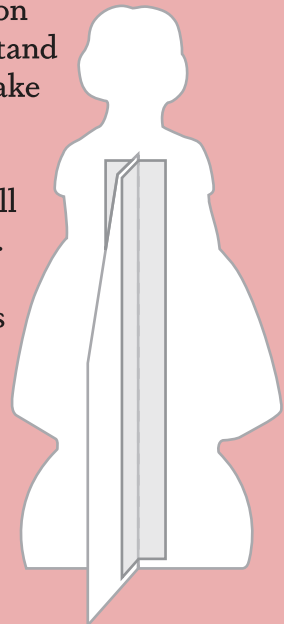

long edge of stand support with
center back of doll. Add a piece
of clear tape on
each side of stand
support to make
a hinge.
